



Kenny Gage and Devon Downs are American filmmakers based in Los Angeles. Cynthia is the 6th feature film the team has directed. The digital Horror series, The Last One which Gage/Downs directed for BET Networks won the 2018 Cynopsis award for "Best Series StandAlone Short from a TV Network". Their directing debut feature Anarchy Parlor, was filmed entirely in Vilnius, Lithuania, receiving critical praise "...there are moments of both gore and suspense that are clear evidence of Downs and Gage's talent behind the camera." Anarchy Parlor



was subsequently released in AMC theaters in the U.S. in May of 2015. The duo is becoming known as the go to directors for Thrillers, with an emphasis on action sequences.
