

BIOS

DEREK AHONEN (Writer/Director)- Derek Ahonen is an internationally acclaimed playwright, director, and filmmaker. He is the founder of the award winning Amoralists Theatre Company in New York, whose mission is to produce work of "no moral judgment" while representing an "honest expression of the American condition." Notable works include The Pied Pipers of The Lower East Side, Happy in the Poorhouse, The Bad and The Better, and The Qualification of Douglas Evans.

His feature film debut, The Transcendents made it's world premiere at the 20th Annual Sarasota Film Festival on April 18th, 2018. It went on to make it's European premiere at The Madrid International Film Festival in July of the same year where it won the award for Best Original Screenplay of a feature film.

Ahonen's work has been lauded by The New York Times, The New Yorker and Variety amongst many others. The New York Times has said that "Mr. Ahonen has a showman's sensibility. He brings the populist instincts of a born entertainer." While The New York Post calls Ahonen's shows "Like no other. A distinctive mix of hyper realism, satire, brash violence, and unexpected tenderness." Time Out New York says that "Nobody else weds old-fashioned realist structure and working-class-hero lunacy quite this way." The Village Voice describes his work as "Scathing and frequently hilarious portraits of the American dream gone wrong." The New Yorker says "Ahonen is very funny, original and refreshing." New York Magazine calls Ahonen a "brass-knuckled absurdist" and The Connecticut Post says "Ahonen is part journalist, part philosopher and part saloon poet." Finally, New York Press calls his work "Carefully stylized mayhem. A complex symphony that should be marveled at."

MELINDA PRISCO (PRODUCER)- Melinda is an Italian-Hungarian film producer. She was educated at the International College of Spain. Feature Film credits include: MOM (Distrital Works In Progress), SUMMUM BONUM (East End, Lost Coabos),, and NOBLE EARTH (Raindance, Los Cabos, Seattle), in addition to her work on short films, music videos and web series. Melinda is also the founder of the streaming service FILMATIQUE.

JEFF MELANSON (DIRECTOR OF PHOTOGRAPHY)- Jeff Melanson is a cinematographer based in Brooklyn. HIs collaborations with director Charles Frank, MY BABY YOU"LL BE and JUNK MAIL have each earned Vimeo Staff Pick, and his Super 16-shot music video for Royksopp's won the band's contest to become the son's official video. Beyond, THE TRANSCENDENTS, and Lauren Rotary's short film SHELLY, Jeff's works can be seen in the feature film LET ME MAKE YOU A MARTYR, starring Mark Boone Jr, Michael Potts, and Marilyn Manson.

THOMAS M VOGT (EDITOR)- Thomas M. Vogt was the lead editor of the South Park television series from 1998 to 2006. He also edited the South Park: Bigger, Longer & Uncut and Team America: World Police. Vogt also edited POM Wonderful Presents: The Greatest Movie Ever Sold and Mansome with director Morgan Spurlock.

FRANCESCO MARCOCCI (COMPOSER)- Francesco is a multi-fluent, classically trained musician from Pisa, Italy. His critically acclaimed debut album, FOLKORICO is an accumulation of influences as vast as the waters which surrounds his homeland and spreads to the ancient beyond. THE TRANSCENDENTS marks Francesco's first foray into scoring feature films.

ROB FRANCO (*ROGER*)- Rob Franco is an actor and musician most known for his work with the band THE VENUS ILLUMINATO and DRAGONFLY JONES. His feature film work include: SICARIO: DAY OF THE SOLDADO, INTERROGATION, WE CAN BE HEROES, MIDNIGHT TEXAS, AMERICAN CRIME, and SIN CITY 2.

SAVANNAH WELCH (KIM)- Savannah Welch is an actress and musician most known for her work with the band, THE TRISHAS. Her feature film credits include: BOYHOOD, THE TREE OF LIFE, SIX, SONG TO SONG, THE SINNER, AND BILLY BATES.

KATHY VALENTINE (JAN)- Kathy Valentine is a legendary musician and most known for her years as both a composer and bassist for the iconic band THE GO GO's. THE TRANSCENDENTS marks Kathy's feature film debut.

WILLIAM LeROY (GEORGE)- William LeRoy is an actor and producer most known from his show BAGGAGE BATTLES. Formally the owner of the legendary BILLY'S ANTIQUES on Houston St in NYC, Billy has transitioned into acting with starring roles in THE TRANSCENDENTS, BOUREK, DON PEYOTE, and DIRTY OLD TOWN.

BEN RENO (FOSTER)- Ben Reno is an actor/producer, and a post company graduate of the prestigious American Academy of Dramatic Arts. A lifetime member of New York's infamous theatre company The Amoralists, Ben's film work includes: THE TRANSCENDENTS, HOW WE BUILT THE BOMB, THE FEVER AND THE FRET, and TERMINUS.

CECILIA DEACON (CECILIA) - Cecilia Deacon, a Canadian actress born in Ontario, graduated from New York's American Academy of Dramatic Arts. Deacon has taken to the New York stage in productions at the Lester Martin Theatre, the Mary MacArthur Theatre, and the Mannie Greenfield Theatre. She has modeled for brands such as L'Oreal, Redken, Truvivity and Cetaphil. Deacon was featured in the hit comedy "The Buddy Games," starring Josh Duhamel ("Transformers", "Safe Haven", "When in Rome") and Dax Shepard ("Hit and Run," "Employee of the Month," "Bless This Mess") and has accrued roles in popular shows such as Legends of Tomorrow, Altered Carbon, and Charmed.
