Sexton made his film debut in Todd Solondz's Welcome to the **Dollhouse** playing the troubled bully Brandon McCarthy, for which he was nominated for an Independent Spirit Award. He was the lead in Hurricane Streets and **Desert Blue** and also appeared in Boys Don't Cry, Black Hawk Down, and Just Like the Son, as well as the cult films Empire Records and Pecker. He also starred in AMC's The Killing. Recent films also include El Camino: A Breaking Bad Movie and Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri and the Netflix series Russian Doll.

Essoe's breakout was the starring role in Starry Eyes, which premiered at the SXSW festival. She recently starred in Doctor Sleep and will be seen next in Netflix's Midnight Mass. She also appeared in the horror anthology movie Tales of Halloween and The Neighbor. She also appeared alongside Mickey Rourke and Bill Murray in the drama Passion Play and feature films Fashionista and The Maestro.

# DIRECTOR

While attending NYU, Marcel collaborated on a series of Off-Broadway plays including Birth and After Birth starring Rent headliner Anthony Rapp and Robert Sean Leonard, as well as the Impossibility of Romantic Relationships in the Final Minutes of the Twentieth Century with Ethan Hawke.

During this time Marcel also was an assistant to David Lynch on his theatrical piece at the Brooklyn Academy of Music with Twin Peaks composer Angelo Badalamenti, starring Laura Dern and Nicolas Cage.

After dropping out of film school two years later when the thesis film he produced and co-wrote won a New York University First Run Festival Award, he moved to L.A., optioned a screenplay to the producer of Buffy the Vampire Slayer and was invited into the FOX SEARCHLIGHT director's lab.


There he wrote and directed It's Better to be Wanted For Murder, Than Not to Be Wanted At All, starring Zooey Deschanel, Marco Leonardi, and Laura Harris. After setting up a few more screenplays, Marcel eventually raised the money to direct his first feature, Heavy Petting, a funky and absurd comedy starring Malin Akerman, Brendan Hines, and Kevin Sussman.

Next Marcel co-produced & directed the coming-of-age horror feature, Deadgirl, which premiered at the 2008 Toronto Film Festival. A ten-city limited theatrical run electrified audiences, with many calling it "the worst film dared to be made", but others like The Boston Globe calling it "one of the Top 10 zombie movies of all time". Ain't it Cool News added, "The thing's pretty much fucking brilliant."

His segment for the ABC's Of Death, D is Dogfight, brought him back to Toronto's acclaimed Midnight Madness section in 2012, where the New York Times praised, "None linger quite like D Is for Dogfight, a mesmeric, slow-motion ballet of brutality," while the Village Voice added, "A marvel of suggestion that's the movie's visual high point."

Marcel was also one of the directors featured on a forthcoming third installment of the popular horror anthology, V/H/S.

Marcel's most recent feature was Totem, produced by BLUMHOUSE and acquired by HBO. Coming next in 2021 is The Royal.







