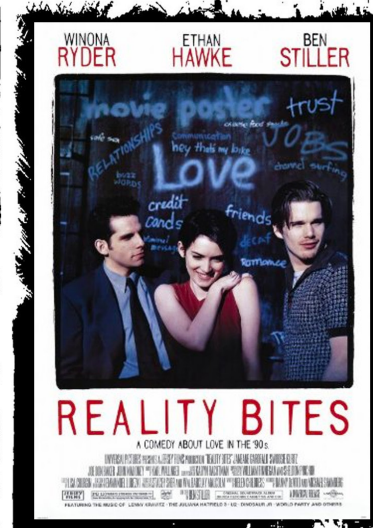
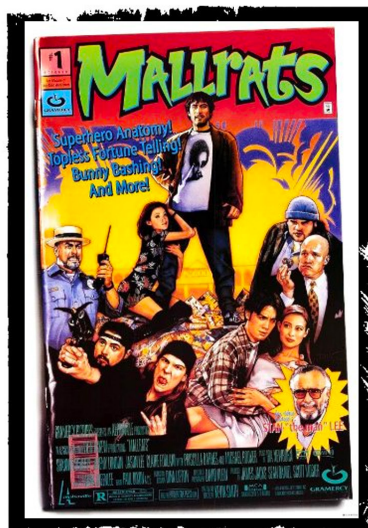
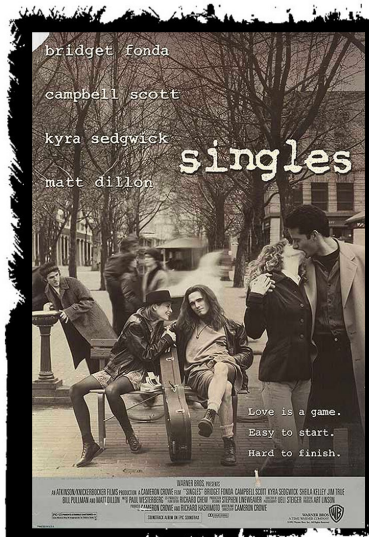


THE STORY

By combining blocking and maximizing our set-ups, we will be able to give this movie a fluid and energetic tone that only slows down when it's important to show character growth.






