

THE VISION

Since I was a child I have always been drawn to genre films. I begged my mom to let me rent Alien from the public library when I was 7 or 8 years old. It opened the floodgates and by the time I was in middle school my obsession with films took me through all the horror films of the 80s and 90s. I was watching A Nightmare on Elm Street, The Shining, Evil Dead, Hellraiser and The Thing. John Carpenter became one of my favorite filmmakers.

Though I was obsessed with making images, my screenwriting always gravitated toward slasher films of that time period. While I was shooting the feature film The Pale Man the director, John Lerchen, gave me a copy of the script for The Lurker. After years of trying to find the right script for my thesis, I had found it. It had everything I was looking for and the perfect way to make an homage to my favorite movies and filmmakers.

The Lurker centers on a group of high school students finishing a production of Romeo and Juliet. As student and faculty begin to die, it's a race against time to find the killer and escape with their lives. The story, setting and characters gave me the ability to experiment with tension, suspnse, humor and surprise. The film is my calling card but it is also a learning experience for my next endeavor as a director.
