LOGLINE:

An ancient Chippewa demon, the WINDIGO, is resurrected by a Native American teenager and his grandmother to protect their family after a run-in with back-woodsmeth dealers. They soon discover that the creature's lust for killing cannot be controlled. As each killing bonds the teen and the Windigo ever closer, the family must find a way to break the curse before all of them become the blood-thirsty creature's next victims.

SYNOPSIS:

GRANDMOTHER's nightmares are getting worse. She has been haunted by the WINDIGO -- an ancient Chippewa demon -- her entire life. She tells everyone that she's been doomed by a sin she did not commit, but for which she must ultimately pay. Driven half mad by a horrific dream, Grandmother makes a frantic call to the only family she has left in this world--CLAIRE was raised in Grandmother's home, so when she gets the frantic midnight call from the terrified old woman, she wastes no time packing up her two teen-age children, RY and BREE, and driving them all from California to the remote farm in Northern Michigan to care for her Grandmother. When they arrive, the vast number of dream catchers that adorn Grandmother's farmhouse (for protection against evil) are even more than Claire remembers from her youth. The old woman must be truly terrified. Ry and Bree have never seen anything like the remote woods where Grandmother lives. Bree is excited to explore the land and her Chippewa heritage. Ry is less enthused. No cell service, no cable television...One day while Ry and Bree explore the woods, they stumble upon a back-woods drug lab and the three vicious METH-HEADS who run it. Ry is nearly killed before Bree is able to rescue him and they escape. Ry is terrified for his life. The local sheriff is no help against the meth-heads. Ry desperately then turns to an unlikely source of help...Grandmother knows a way to save him. She secretly teaches Ry how to conjure the Windigo. The blood-thirsty demon will punish those who would do Ry harm, and it will never stop until the last of the evil that it was called upon to battle is consumed. The Windigo is brought to life. The meth-heads die gruesome, much deserved deaths at the hands of the Windigo. Unfortunately, Ry's connection with the demon grows stronger with each death until Ry and the Windigo are as one.
